

# Huachuca Mountain Naturalist Saunter!



The Huachuca Mountains are one of the tallest and largest of our stunning Sky Island ranges. Naturalist, Ethnobotanist, and Wildlife Biologist Vincent Pinto will guide you into the heart of the Huachucas, taking you on a series of slow-paced Naturalist walks in a wide variety of habitats - including grasslands, woodlands, forests, and canyons. You'll have an chance to spot wildlife characteristic of this border range, including: **White-nosed Coati, Bobcat, Mexican Jay, AZ Woodpecker, Mexican Spotted Owl, Scaled Quail, Golden Eagle, Northern Goshawk, Band-tailed Pigeon,** and wintering **Warblers & Flycatchers**, to name a few. Ethnobotany will be another focus of this Naturalist Saunter, as Vincent will point out many of the area's native plants, while demonstrating their uses. **Distance: 3 miles roundtrip. Terrain: varies from flat & easy to rocky & moderate. Level: Easy.**
