March is primetime for spring wildflowers in the Sonoran Desert and Sky Islands region. With a bewildering array of species, it's often difficult to recognize each one. Botanist and Naturalist Vincent Pinto will guide you to several different areas in search of the broadest possible spectrum of native wildflowers. With a huge range of sizes, shapes, colors, and pollinators, Vincent will discuss the natural history of each species encountered, illuminating its distinct character. A diversity of Butterflies may also be in flight during our walk. Given the vagaries of rain, Vincent will determine the exact locations of the expedition just prior to the trip. Bring your camera to capture the beauty of the floral display. **Distance: 2.5 miles.** **Terrain: varies from flat to rolling w/ some rocky sections.** **Level: Easy.**
