

New Mexico Sky Islands: 3 Day Naturalist Journey



The Sky Islands mountains of the southwest harbor many remote and off-the-beaten-path destinations that promise both scenic beauty and memorable wildlife encounters. Join Naturalist & Wildlife Biologist Vincent Pinto for 2 full days of leisurely walks into several different Sky Island mountains near and in the border of New Mexico. There you'll learn about the fascinating geology of each range, while searching for and enjoying it's unique wildlife and native plants. We may well encounter species as diverse as Peregrine Falcon, the endangered White-sided Jackrabbit, Pronghorn, as well as other characteristic fauna that inhabit the wide range of plant communities you'll be exploring. Along the way you'll also enjoy spring wildflowers, explore an active cienaga (marsh), visit a historic ranch, and discover the area near where Geronimo finally surrendered!

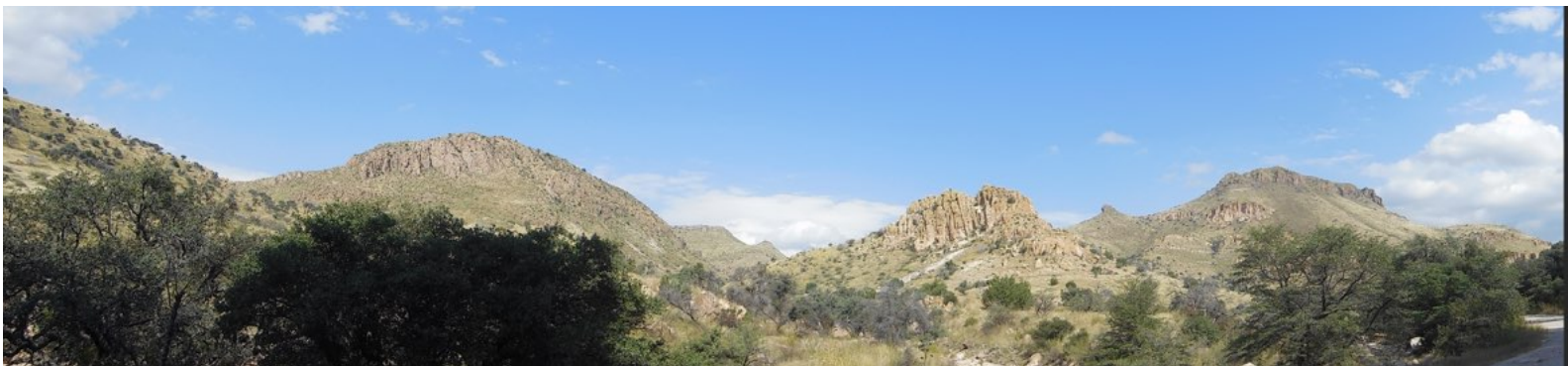
