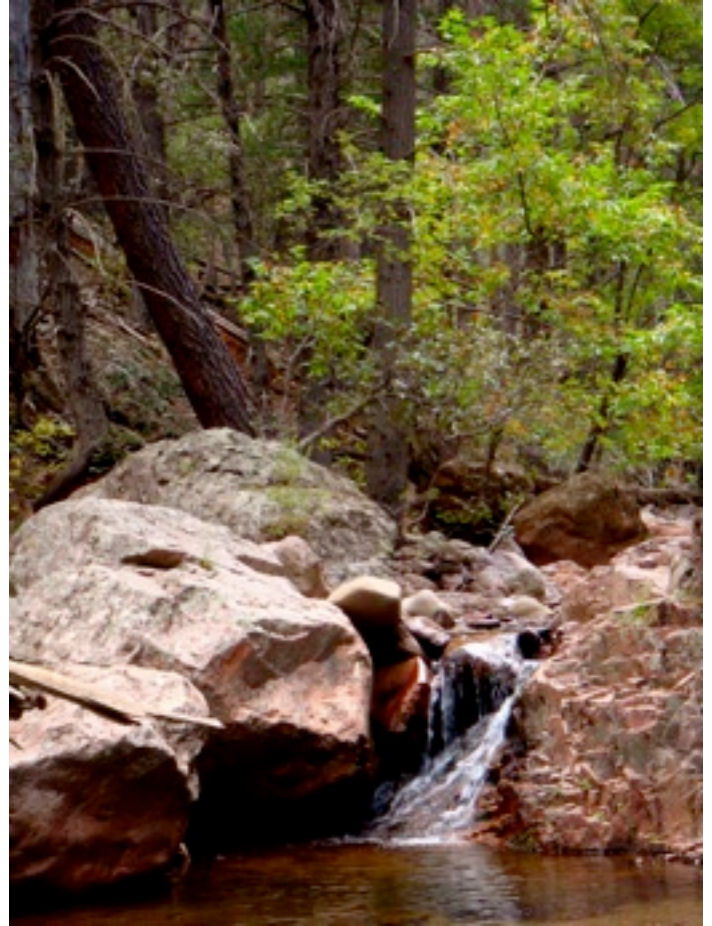


CHIRICAHUA MOUNTAINS EXPEDITION!

Join Wildlife Biologist, Ethnobotanist, Naturalist, & Wilderness Survival Instructor Vincent Pinto who has been exploring the Chiricahua Mountains since 1990, for a Naturalist expedition into the largest of Arizona's famed Sky Islands. During this exciting long weekend you'll have an opportunity to discover this remote & stunning landscape, including a number of fascinating habitats - from deep canyons up to soaring peaks w/ incredible views. Given its proximity to Mexico, the Chiricahuas host an impressive biodiversity, w/ many species at the northern terminus of their range. Such "Mexican Specialties" include: **Elegant Trogon, Buff-breasted Flycatcher, Short-tailed Hawk, Montezuma Quail, Whiskered Screech Owl, Arizona Woodpecker, Magnificent Hummingbird, Mexican Chickadee, Painted Redstart, Jaguar, White-nosed Coati, Striped Plateau Lizard, & numerous plants** normally found mostly south of the border. We'll take a relaxed pace during this Naturalist's Saunter while searching for a wide range of flora & fauna, as well as unique geology. We'll also cover the human uses of many native plants, track local wildlife, & learn about the Arizona's brilliant night sky, Owls, and other creatures of the night!
